During the month the Company had the following activities:

During the month the Company reviewed and released data from a recently completed 1,848-meter diamond drilling program on its mineral exploration leases in the state of Arizona. Readers should review news release from the Company, dated April 26, 2024 (can be found out SEDAR+ and the Company's website).

Geologists continued to synthesize lithium exploration data from work in Nunavik, and the James Bay Camp in Quebec, and develop plans for next phase exploration. In addition, the Company has been evaluating additional resource projects and claim staking plans.

On May 2, 2024, the announced a non-brokered private placement of up to 8,500,000 units (the "Units") of the Company at a price of C\$0.195 per Unit (the "Offering Price") for gross proceeds to the Company of up to C\$1,657,500 (the "Offering").

Subject to compliance with applicable regulatory requirements and in accordance with National Instrument 45-106 - Prospectus Exemptions ("NI 45-106"), the Offering is being made to purchasers resident in each of the Provinces of Canada, except Quebec, pursuant to the listed issuer financing exemption under Part 5A of NI 45-106 (the "Exemption"). In connection with the Offering, the Company may pay finder's fees consisting of: (i) cash finder's fees of up to 7% of the gross proceeds of the Offering; and (ii) finder warrants ("Finder's Warrant") in an amount equal to up to 7% of the number of Units issued pursuant to the Offering, exercisable at a price of \$0.30 per common share for a period of 24 months following the closing date of the Offering which will also be subject to the above acceleration clause.

The Company plans to use the net proceeds of this financing for exploration, evaluation of new resource projects, general and administrative expenses which will include funds for marketing and investor relations fees and cash for working capital.
